SPORTS

Aqua Park (Pool, Water Slide)

The Aqua Park spans from the slide entrances on deck 18 to the two pools and five hot tubs on deck 15.

As well as the Epic Plunge, there are two additional water slides, one green and one pink that are both accessed on deck 18 and twist and turn their way down to deck 15 where they both exit into their own shallow area. Height and age restrictions are not applicable but children are not permitted to go down with adults so must be confident enough to go down the slide alone.

The two pools feature an array of water fountains which are mood lit at night and hot tubs and open from 8am to midnight.

Aqua Park Swimming Pools

The ship's two main outdoor swimming pools can be found on deck 15 within the Aqua Park and feature an array of water fountains.

The Rectangular pool reaches a depth of 1.75m (5'9") by the slide exit end whilst the other pool ranges from a shallow 0.3m (1ft) depth to 1.4m (4'7").

Water Slide

The Epic Plunge is a three storey 236 feet long tube bowl slide starting on deck 18 and spiralling down to its own shallow exit on deck 15. It has no height or age restrictions but guests can't go down together and children need to be large enough to use the ring tubes provided to go down the slide.

Two additional three storey twisting water slides are also on Epic which again enter into their own exit by the water park and are not height or age specific.

Sports Court

The Sports Complex on deck 17 features two decks, a full-sized basketball court which also serves as a multipurpose hockey, dodgeball and football court. Plus a full sized batting cage.

Table Tennis

Table Tennis tables are set up on some days by Spice H2O aft of deck 15.

Climbing Wall (Rock Wall)

Epic's 37-foot-high and 64-foot-wide rock climbing and rappelling (abseiling) wall can be found on deck 15 of the ship.

With all equipment provided, guests must sign an E-Waiver form stating that they have been instructed fully on using the apparatus before they take part in the rock climbing.

Shuffleboard (Traditional Deck Games) Shuffleboard is located on the Promenade Deck (7).

Giant Outdoor Chess (Traditional Deck Games) Giant Chess Play is available aft of deck 15.

Bowling Alley

Ten pin bowling alleys are located on deck 6 in O'Sheehan's Bar and deck 7 in Bliss.

A charge of \$5 per game applies.

Jogging Track

The ship's outdoor jogging track is located on deck 7 with 2.3 laps equal to 1km (3.8 lap's equal 1 mile).

The Internet is accessible on the Norwegian Epic either via the 24 hour iConnect Internet Cafe on deck 5 or guests' own Wi-Fi enabled devices.

Wireless connectivity is available throughout the ship allowing guests to use their own personal laptops, iPhones or other Wi-Fi equipped devices along with most software installed on them without restrictions. Other classes include Body Sculpt Boot Camp (\$120 for 4 sessions), Tour de Cycle (\$60 for four classes), Pilates and Yoga (\$30 for 3 classes or \$12 per class).

Personal training is also on offer at \$85 per hour.

Mandara Spa: The Spa has a host of facilities including saunas and steam rooms, relaxation areas, a mood lit heated thalassotherapy pool which is 1.3m deep and heated ceramic relaxation lounges.

Spice H2O (Daytime, Adult Only Pool, Garden/Relaxation Area)

Spice H20 is a beach club located on deck 15 with its own grill, bar, pool and hot tubs and Ibiza inspired atmosphere with its own large outdoor LED screen.

It can accommodate up to 164 guests and is an adult only venue until 8pm.

Courtyard Pool (Adult Only Pool)

The Courtyard Pool on deck 16 is exclusively for guests staying in the Villas Complex and includes two hot tubs and is surrounded by plush deck chairs and private cabanas.

The Courtyard Pool is 1.2m/4ft 2in deep.

Spa Pool (Adult Only Pool)

The Spa Pool in the Mandara Spa on deck 14 is a thalassotherapy pool with waterfalls and relaxing mood lighting.

At 1.3m deep, the warm, mineral rich pool with hydrotherapy water jets helps ease general aches and pains.
